

FOR FIRE INSIDE THE ROOM:

- 1. CALL THE FIRE DEPARTMENT 9-911
 - A. Tell Them Your Exact Location
 - B. Explain What is Burning
- 2. CALL THE HOTEL OPERATOR "0"
- 3. Alert Others in the area and activate Fire Alarms






Natural Gas Price Projections






LNG & Power Demand Growth









Production Outlook

US lower-48 gas production growth is set to resume this spring following a production slowdown during the first quarter






Production Overview


