

^{*} These locations are used on storage withdrawals only. These locations are used when the withdrawn quantity is to be delivered to another shipper and not used by the shipper holding the storage contract. When these locations are used, the transmission fuel charge is passed to the transporting shipper.


STORAGE INJECTION (06 TT) AND OVERRUN INJECTION (12 TT)



- 1) Storage injections originate with a receipt nomination at a determined point,
- 2) Followed by a delivery to the storage location,
- 3) Which is then transported on a path nomination,
- 4) To ultimately be received on the storage contract using either the 06 or 12 transaction type.



STORAGE WITHDRAWAL (07 TT) AND OVERRUN WITHDRAWAL (13 TT)




- 1) Storage withdrawals originate with a delivery nomination out of the storage contract using either the 07 or 13 transaction type,
- 2) Followed by a receipt from the storage location,
- 3) A matching delivery nomination to any delivery location,
- 4) And lastly, a path nomination to transport the receipt to the delivery.



ONE SIDED NO-NOTICE NOMINATION (22 TT)

This transaction type is used to inject into a TSS storage account using only the TSS contract. It is most beneficial when the receipt is in the production area and the storage is in the market area. The TSS contract used must have both production area and market area transport.



In this example, location 16294 is in the production area. TS15 has both production and market area transport with the storage located in the market area.
